The El Paso County Elections Department will continue to deputize walk-in in our office located at 500 E. San Antonio Ave., Suite #314, El Paso, Texas 79901 every Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., excluding holidays and election cycle. Groups of a minimum of 25 attendees requesting a private training must contact the Elections Department two week in advance at (915) 546-2154 or at [brnegrete@epcounty.com](mailto:brnegrete@epcounty.com).

Note: After every voter registration deadline, no trainings will be available for public and private groups until after the election. Requests for private trainings will resume five business days after every election.

Volunteer Deputy Registrar appointments made during the **2019 – 2020 cycle will expire on December 31, 2020**. By Texas Law, all Volunteer Deputy Registrar appointments expire on December 31<sup>st</sup> of even-numbered years.
