

NOTICE OF ELECTION

TO THE DULY QUALIFIED RESIDENT VOTERS OF HORIZON REGIONAL MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT

Notice is hereby given that a bond election (the "Election") will be held for Horizon Regional Municipal Utility District (the "District"), pursuant to an Order of the Board of Directors of the District passed on January 28, 2021 (the "Order"). The Order is on file in the District's office located at 2929 Allen Parkway, Suite 3150, Houston, Texas 77019, where any interested person may refer to it for all purposes. Additionally, a copy of the Order is available on the District's website at <https://horizonregional.com/>.

1. The Election shall be held between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 1, 2021, at the polling locations identified as Exhibit "A", attached hereto, and shall conform to all the requirements of Chapters 49 and 54, Texas Water Code, and all of the requirements of the Texas Election Code, so far as applicable.
2. Only duly qualified resident electors of the District may vote at the Election.
3. The propositions to be voted on in the Election are as follows:

PROPOSITION A

SHALL THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS (THE "BOARD") OF HORIZON REGIONAL MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT (THE "DISTRICT") BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE THE BONDS OF SAID DISTRICT IN ONE OR MORE ISSUES OR SERIES IN THE MAXIMUM ORIGINAL PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$225,000,000, MATURING SERIALY OR OTHERWISE OVER A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 40 YEARS FROM THEIR DATE OR DATES, AND TO BE ISSUED AND SOLD AT ANY PRICE OR PRICES AND TO BEAR INTEREST AT ANY RATE OR RATES AS SHALL BE DETERMINED WITHIN THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD OF THE DISTRICT AT THE TIME OF ISSUANCE AS AUTHORIZED BY LAW AS NOW ENACTED OR HEREAFTER AMENDED, FOR THE PURPOSES OF (A) FINANCING THE CONSTRUCTION, REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT OF THE DISTRICT'S WATERWORKS SYSTEM AND SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SUCH BONDS BY THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF A SUFFICIENT TAX UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN SAID DISTRICT, ALL AS AUTHORIZED BY THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS?

PROPOSITION B

SHALL THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS (THE "BOARD") OF HORIZON REGIONAL MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT (THE "DISTRICT") BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE REFUNDING BONDS OF SAID DISTRICT IN ONE OR MORE ISSUES OR SERIES IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$225,000,000, MATURING SERIALY OR OTHERWISE OVER A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 40 YEARS FROM THEIR DATE OR DATES TO BE SOLD AT ANY PRICE OR PRICES AND TO BEAR INTEREST

OR AT ANY RATE OR RATES AS SHALL BE DETERMINED WITHIN THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD AS AUTHORIZED BY LAW AS NOW ENACTED OR HEREAFTER AMENDED, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REFUNDING OF ANY BONDS OR OTHER EVIDENCES OF INDEBTEDNESS OF THE DISTRICT WHICH MAY BE OUTSTANDING FROM TIME TO TIME; AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST ON SUCH REFUNDING BONDS BY THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF A SUFFICIENT AD VALOREM TAX AUTHORIZED BY CHAPTER 49 OF THE TEXAS WATER CODE, UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE DISTRICT ALL AS AUTHORIZED BY THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS?
