New 2024 “I Voted” Sticker Design Contest Winner to be Announced Tomorrow

The winning design for the El Paso County 2024 “I Voted” sticker contest will be announced tomorrow Wednesday, November 15, 2023. “We’ve been incredibly encouraged with the continued interest our El Paso County high school students have shown in this contest,” said Lisa Wise, El Paso County Elections Administrator.

The El Paso County Elections Department received a record breaking 285 submissions for the third edition of the “I Voted” sticker contest. The sticker will be distributed to voters at all Early Voting and Election Day Vote Centers during the 2024 electoral season. The judges will review each submission and select a first, second and third place. Judging will be based on the artistic skill, theme, and uniqueness of the design. Three outstanding members of the community have agreed to participate as judges:
