Note: After every voter registration deadline, no trainings will be available for public and private groups until after the election. Request for private trainings will resume five business days after every election.

Volunteer Deputy Registrar appointments made during the 2023-2024 cycle will expire on December 31, 2024. By Texas Law, all Volunteer Deputy Registrar appointments will expire on December 31st of even-numbered years.
